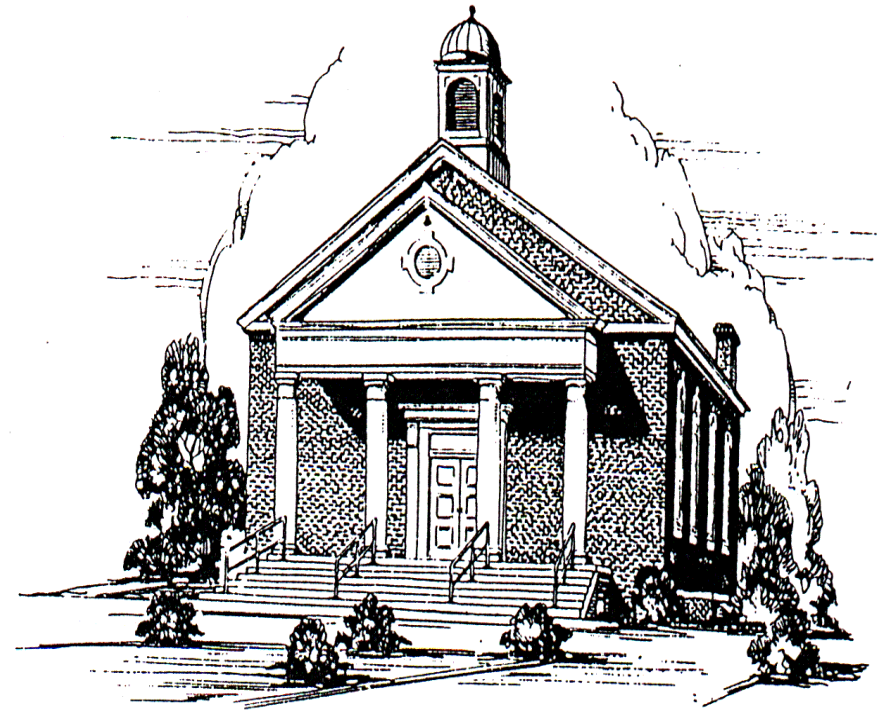
NOTES FROM TODAY'S MESSAGE
